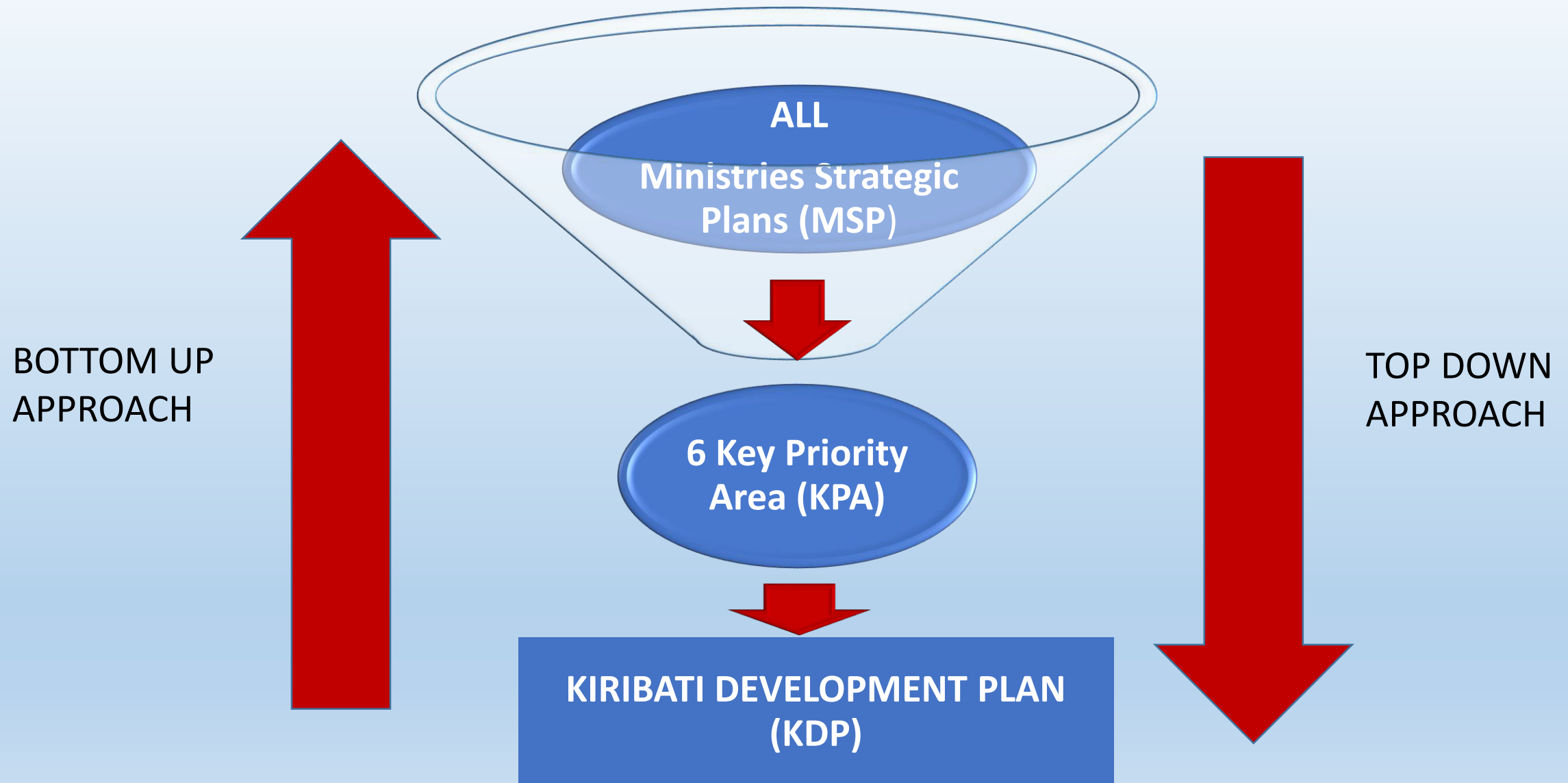

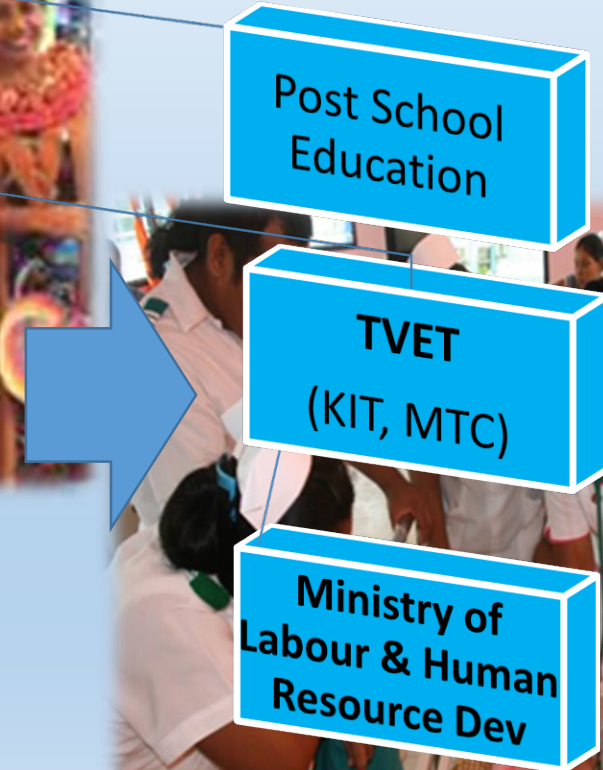

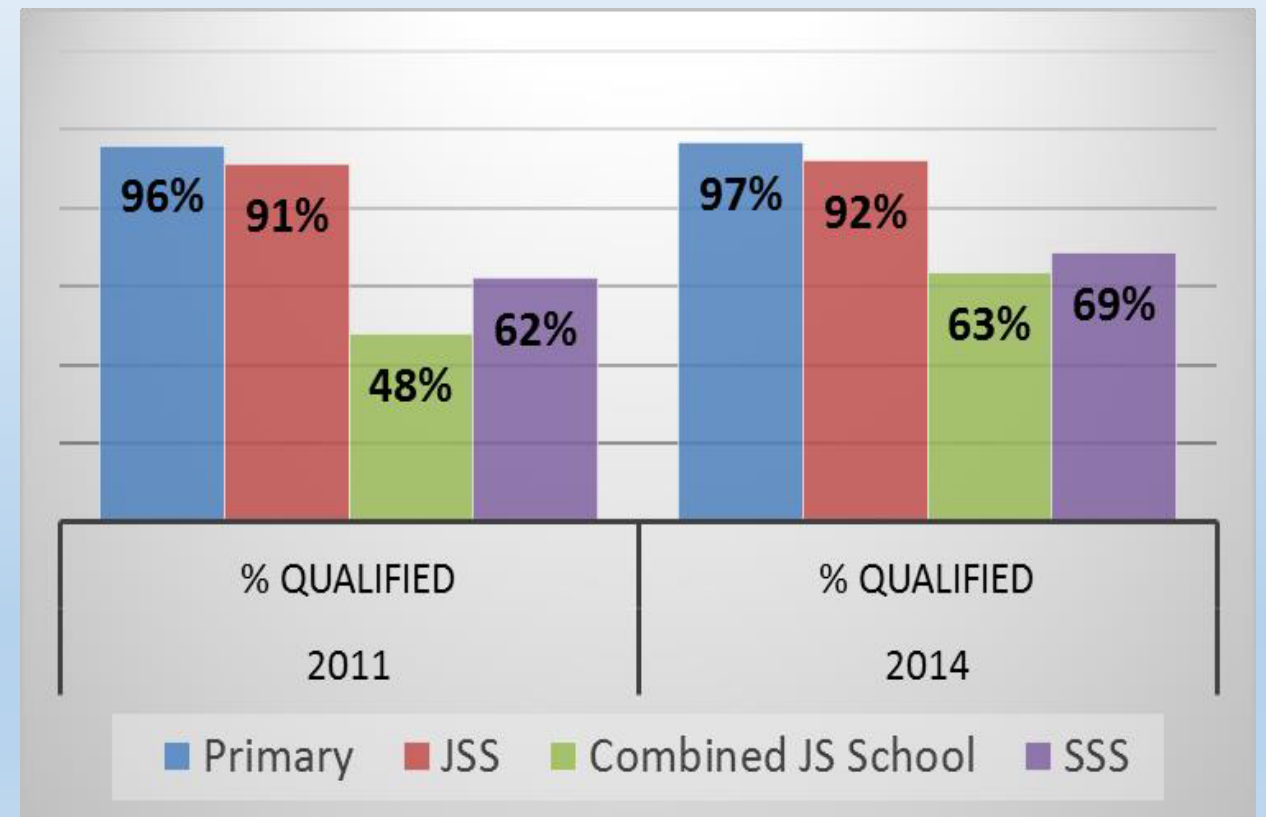

## 3. Proportion of Qualified teachers for 2011 – 2014

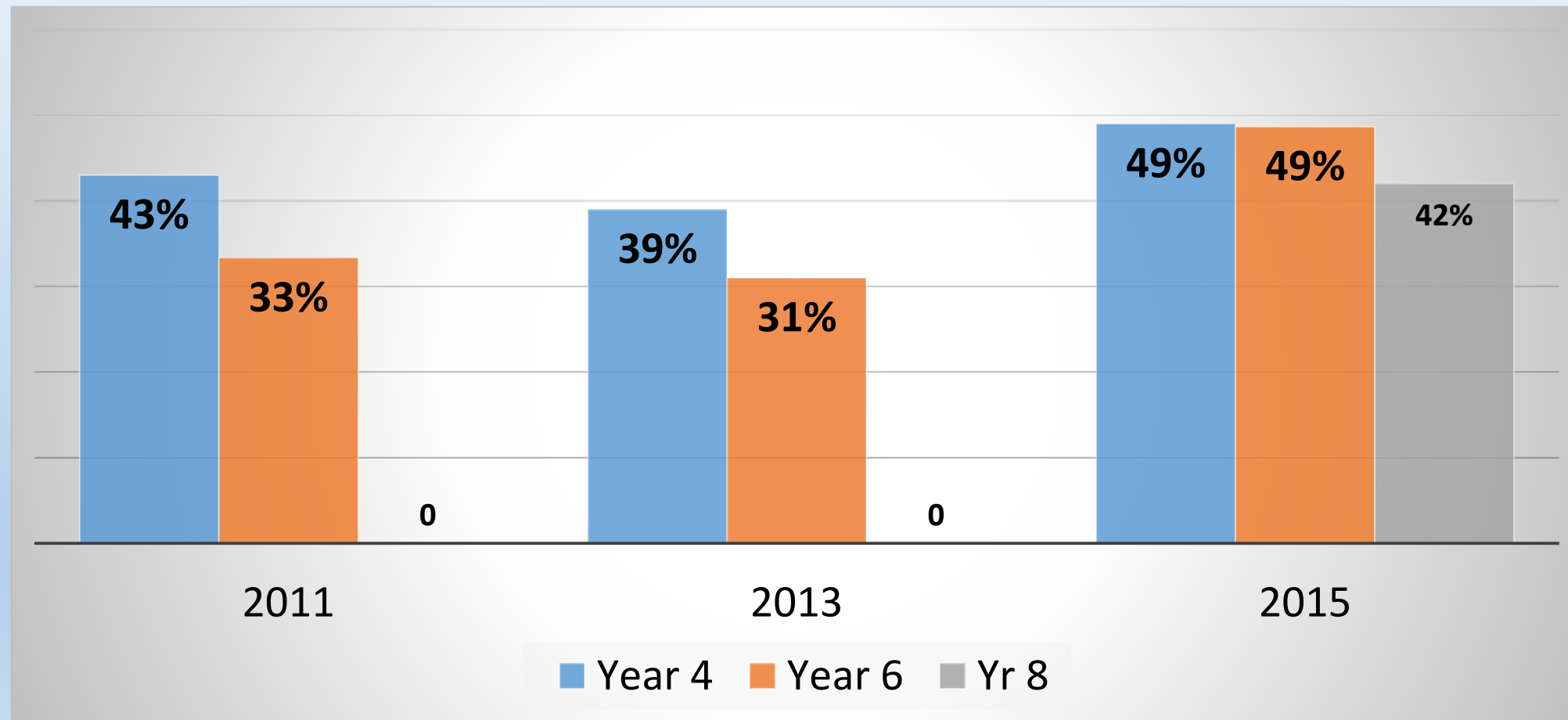

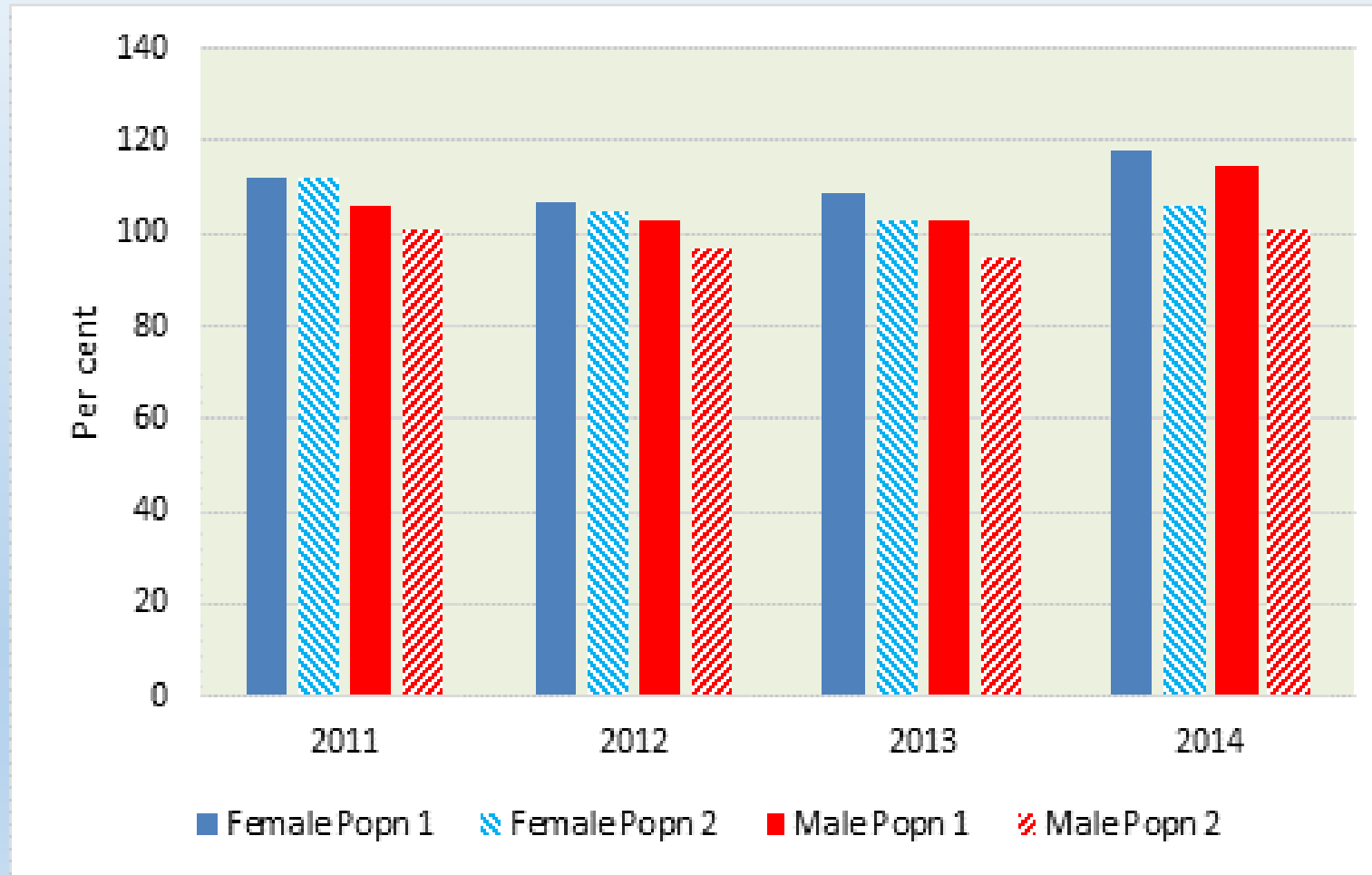

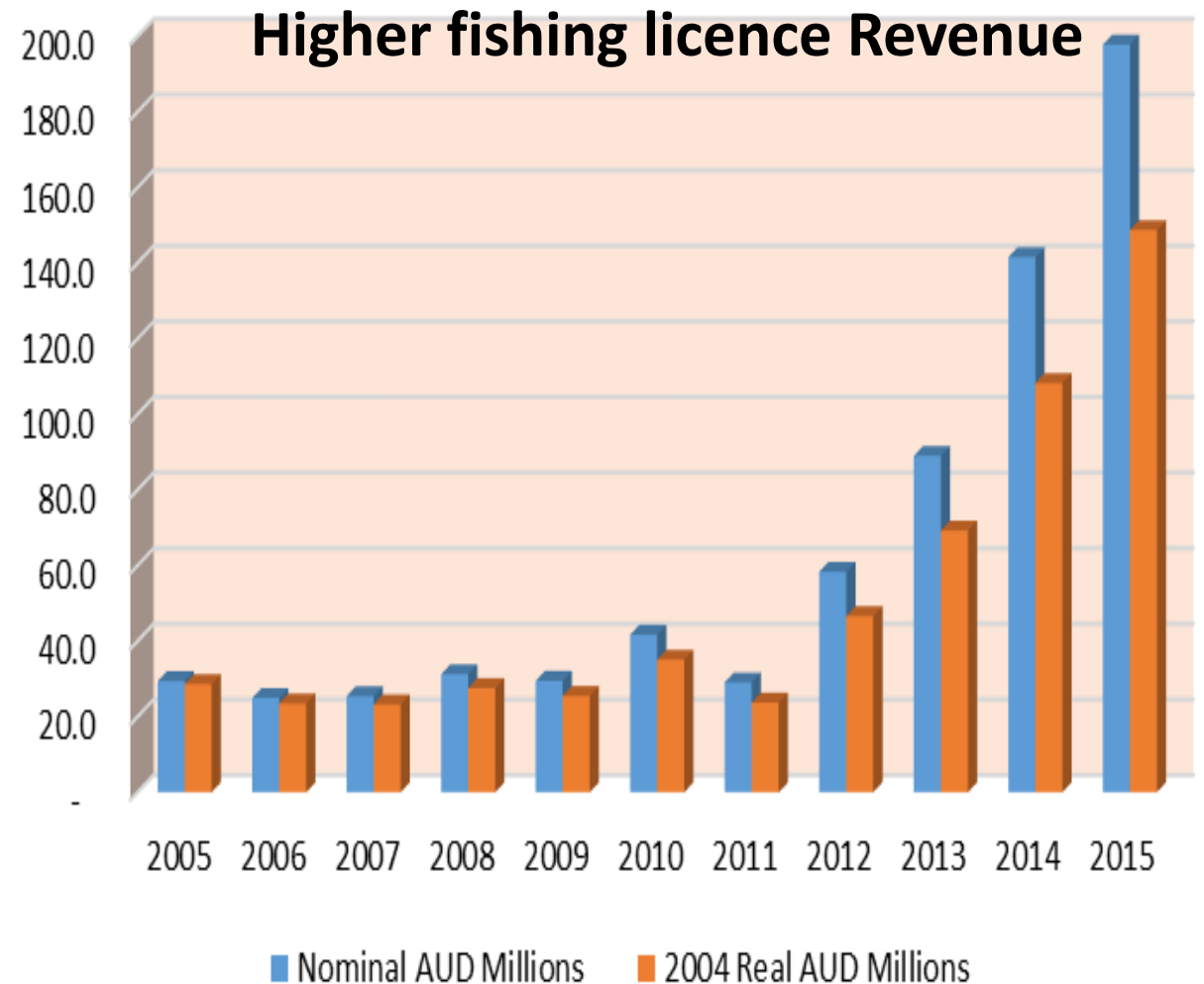

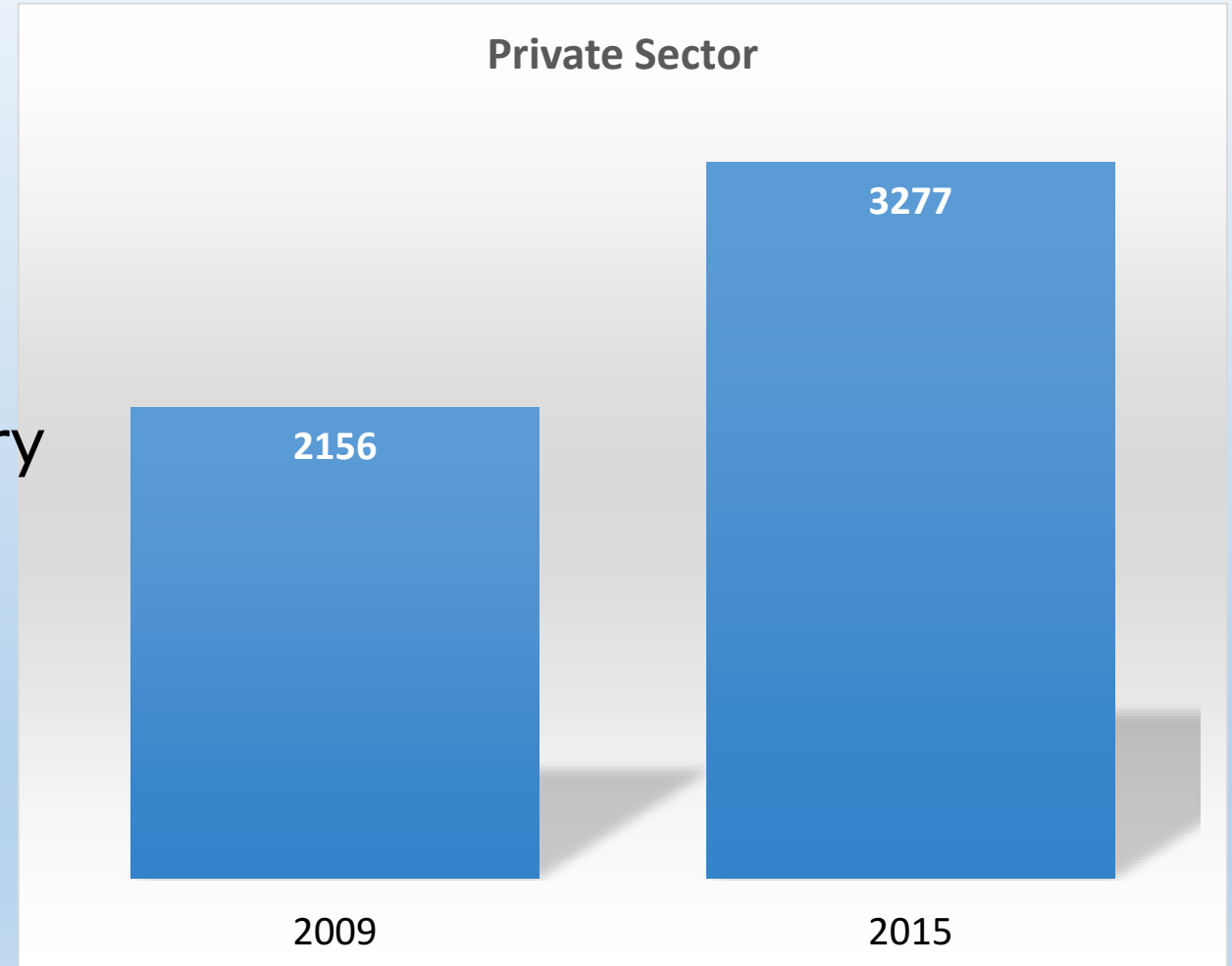
- a) Sustainable approach that led to high collection from fishing licence.

  - I. Merging Kiribati Copra cooperative Society (KCCS) with Kiribati Copra Mill Company Limited (KCMCL)
  - II. New SOE after the merger is now Kiribati Coconut Development Limited (KCDL)

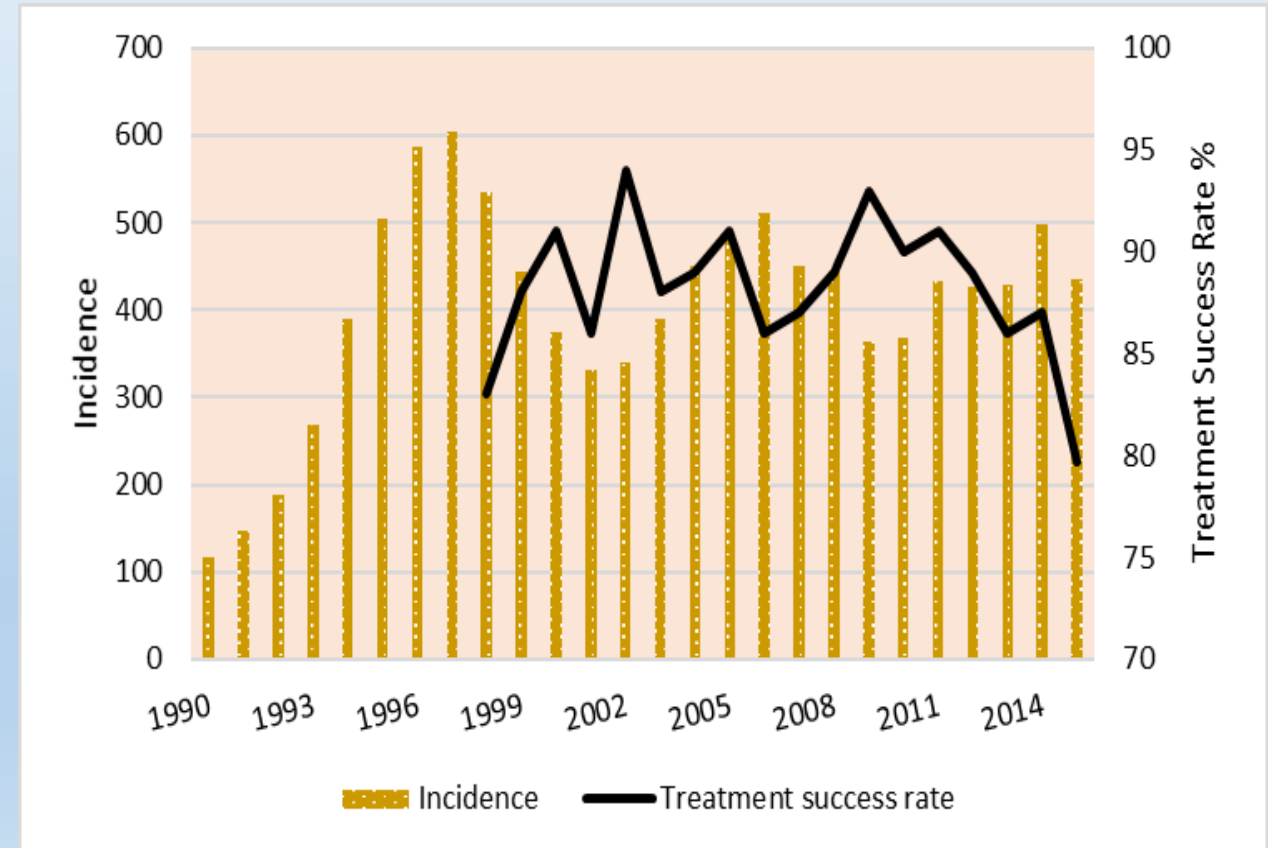
# KPA 3: Health

## 1. Challenges in Health

### a) NCD is a challenge

- Almost  $\frac{3}{4}$  of adult population have some form of NCD risk factors:
  - Elevated blood pressure
  - Smoking
  - Overweight
  - Obesity
- $\frac{1}{4}$  of adults over 25 years are pre-diabetic (on diabetes treatment)

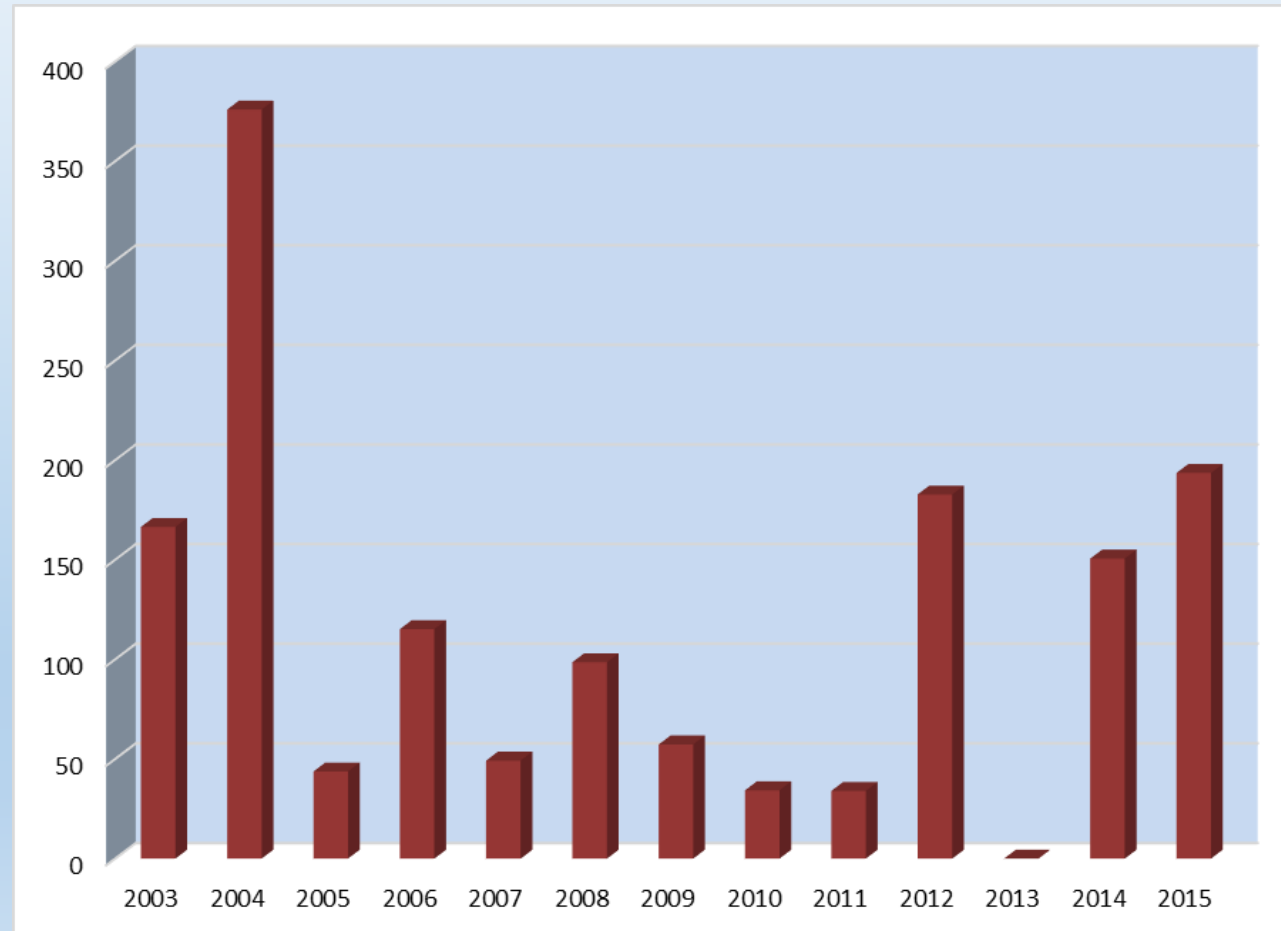

#### a. Maternal Mortality Rate

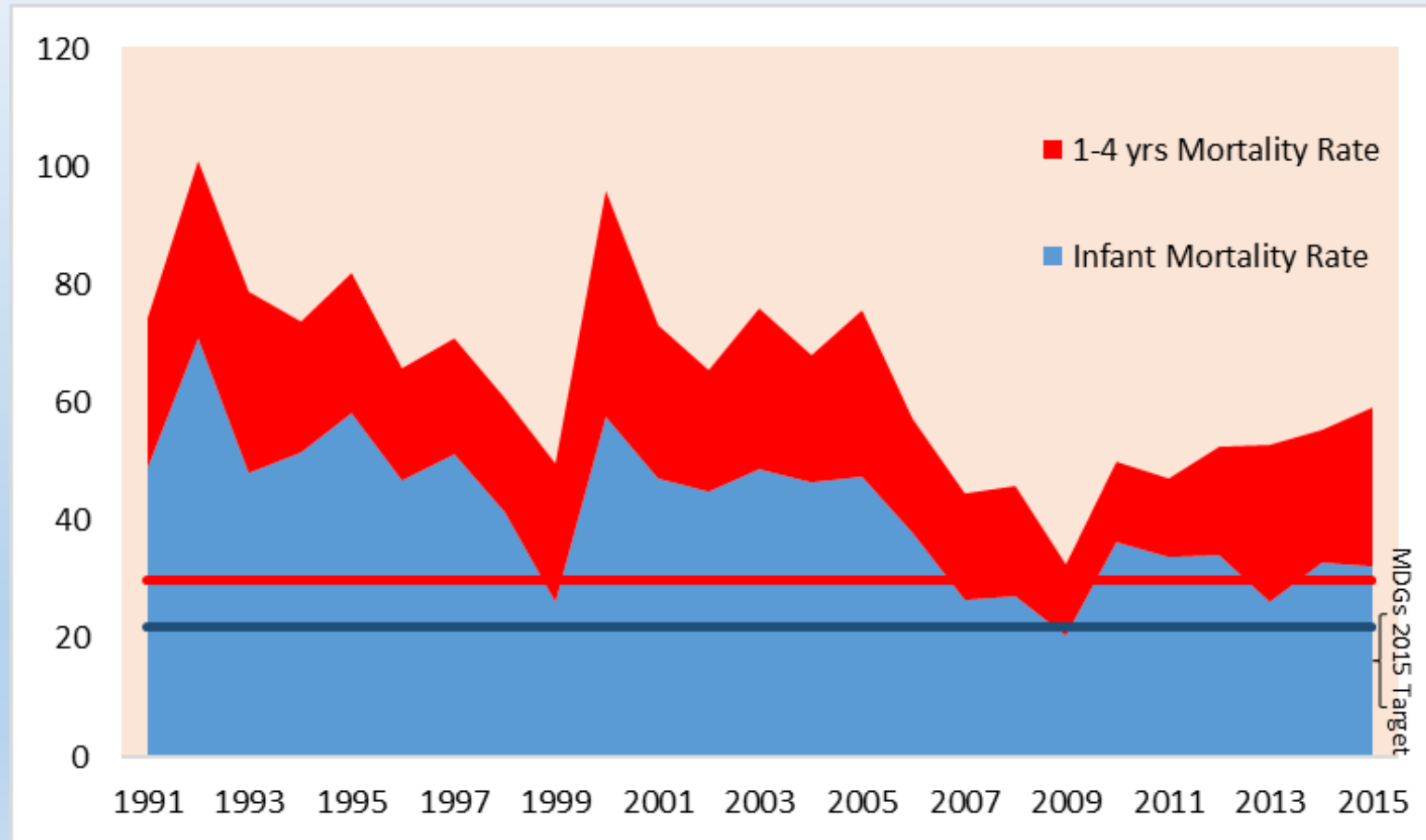

- ✓ Agricultural production support
- ✓ Improvement in solid waste management

#### 2. Sea

- ✓ 1st January 2015 – Phoenix Island Protected Area (PIPA) region declared free from commercial fishing
- ✓ Sustainable extraction of construction aggregates established as an enterprise in 2014

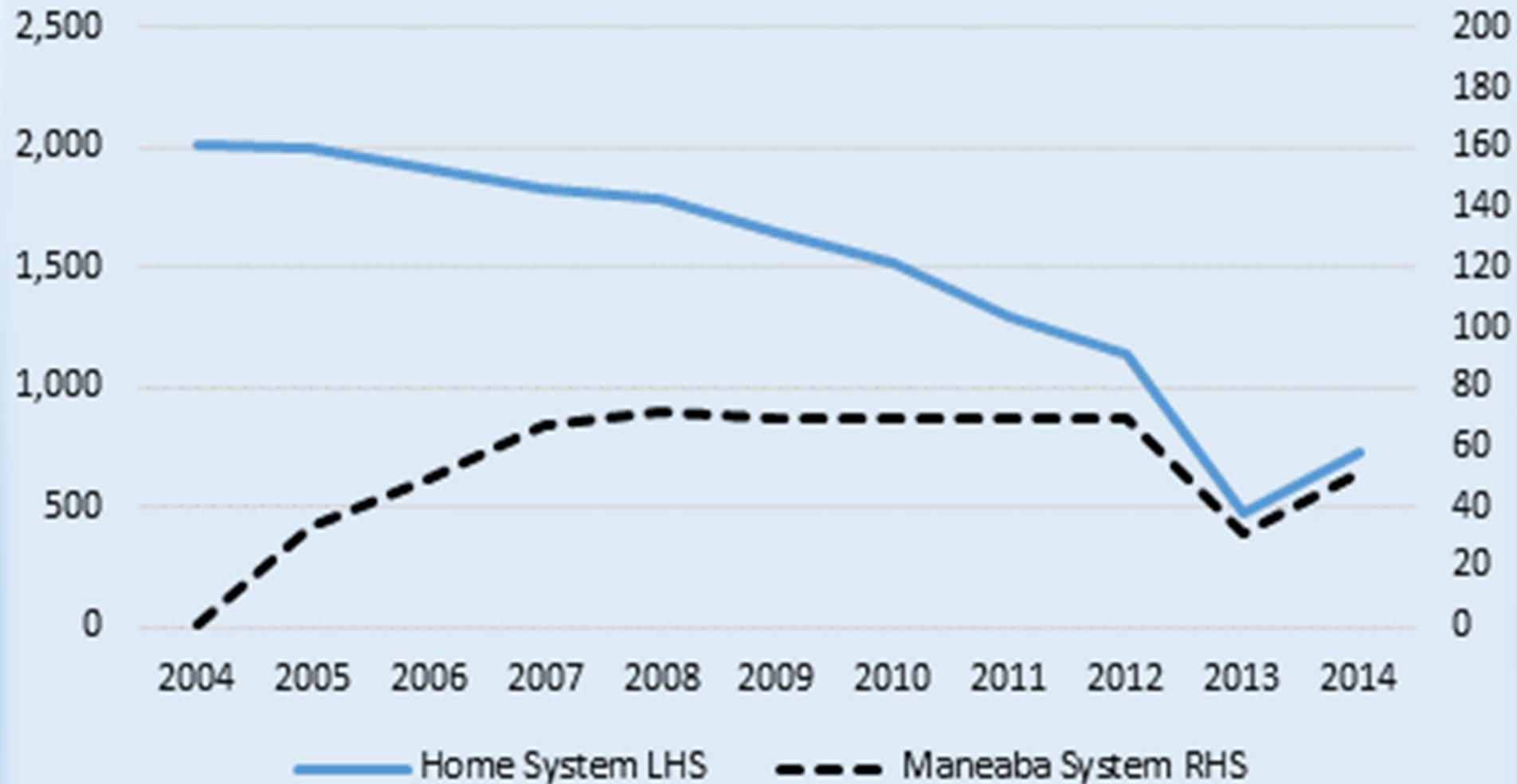
