The Government of Kiribati has received financing from the World Bank towards the cost of the Accelerating Trade Facilitation in the Pacific Project (ATFP) and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

The consulting services (“the Services”) include a part-time national position mentioned above, to form part of the Project Management Unit under the ATFP Project, based in South Tarawa. The Consultants will be engaged on a part-time basis for 30 person-months spread throughout the project duration. The assignments are expected to commence in Quarter 4 of 2025.

The Kiribati Customs Administration & Enforcement (KCAE) as a State-Owned Enterprise under the Ministry of Finance and Economic Development (MFED) now invites eligible individuals (“Consultants”) to indicate their interest in the respective positions. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience (attach curriculum vitae with description of experience in similar assignments, similar conditions, etc.).

The criteria for selecting the Consultant are: -

**Environmental and Social Safeguard Officer (ESSO)**

Mandatory Requirements

- a. Degree in Environmental Science, Environmental Management, Social Science or Social Development, Environmental Law or Engineering, Urban Planning or a related discipline
- b. At least three (3) years’ work experience in the assessment and management of environmental and/ or social impacts with donor or public funded projects.
- c. Sound knowledge of environment and social legislation, regulatory and institutional arrangements in Kiribati.

Desirable Requirements

- a. Fluency in English and I-Kiribati and demonstrated ability to be able to write succinct reports which clearly articulate identified issues.
- b. Previous experience working with donors for example, the World Bank, Asian Development Bank, and similar donors funded projects.
- c. Good communication skills including oral and written communication skills in the substantive and technical areas as described in scope of services.
- d. Preference will be given to candidates not currently engaged in another World Bank – funded assignment.
