The Ministry of Infrastructure and Sustainable Energy (MISE) will implement Sub-Component 2.3 of the Kiribati Outer Island Transport Investment Project (KOITIIP), focusing on rehabilitating causeways on Beru, Nonouti, and Tabiteuea South islands.

The rehabilitation will use the Force Account approach and new positions have been created to support this project. These roles, funded by ADB and WB under KOITIIP for **two years, will later become permanent within MISE.**

MISE is now inviting eligible individuals to express their interest in the following positions:

Shall have the following minimum knowledge, experiences and qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in environmental science and other related fields.
- At least 2 years of general work experience.
