The Government of the Republic of Kiribati (GOK), through the Ministry of Internal Affairs (MIA), is implementing the World Bank-funded 'Kiribati Outer Islands Resilience and Adaptation Project' (KOIRAP). The project's development objectives are to: (i) strengthen the capabilities of island councils for risk-informed land development planning and basic infrastructure and service delivery; and (ii) strengthen the climate resilience of vulnerable communities.

The KOIRAP-MIA now invites eligible individuals ("Consultants") to express their interest in providing the **consulting services ("the Services")** for the following full-time positions: -
